- **2.** The general effect of the Order would be to:
  - (a) Extend the existing "at any time" waiting restrictions on the north-west side of Barbot Close from the common boundary of Nos. 1 and 2 to a point 4.4 metres south of the common boundary of Nos. 6 and 7 Barbot Close;
  - (b) Introduce new "at any time" waiting restrictions on the south-east side of Barbot Close from a point 1.5 metres south-west of a point opposite the common boundary of Nos. 6 and 7 Barbot Close to a point 41 metres south-west of that point;
  - (c) Introduce new "at any time" waiting restrictions on the north-west side of Barbot Close between a point in line with the south-westerly flank wall of flats 14 22 Barbot Close, around the turning head and southern extent of the carriageway and back up the southeast side of Barbot Close by 5.1 metres;
  - (d) Introduce new "at any time" waiting restrictions on the south-east side of Beech Close from a point 1 metre north-east of the common boundary of Nos. 11 and 12 and the south-western kerb-line of Woodstock Crescent;
  - (e) Introduce new "at any time" waiting restrictions on the south-west side of Woodstock Crescent from a point 5 metres south-east of the common boundary of Nos. 12 and 14 Woodstock Crescent and a point 27 metres south-east of that point;
  - (f) Introduce new "at any time" waiting restrictions on the north-west side of Byland Close from the southwestern kerb-line of The Glade and a point 10 metres south-west of that point:
  - (g) Extend the existing "at any time" waiting restrictions on the north-west to south-east arm of Hydefield Court on the south-west side, between a point 14.5 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of the north-east to south-west arm of Hydefield Court and a point 29 metres south-east of a point opposite the north-western wall of Nos. 2 to 24 Hydefield Court;
  - (h) Change all the existing single yellow line restrictions (no parking from 10am 11am Mondays to Fridays inclusive) in Nestor Avenue to "at any time" waiting restrictions;
  - (i) Extend the existing "at any time" waiting restrictions on the south-east side of Tasmania Terrace from the south-western kerb-line of Queensland Avenue to a point 12 metres south-west of the common boundary of Nos. 9 and 11 Tasmania Terrace;
  - (j) Extend the existing "at any time" waiting restrictions on the south-east side of The Ride between the north-eastern kerb-line of Hertford Road and a point 64 metres north-east of that kerb-line;
  - (k) Change the existing single yellow line restrictions (no parking from 8am − 6:30pm Mondays to Saturdays inclusive) in The Ride on the south-east side between a point 10 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Hertford Road and a point 27 metres north-east of that kerb-line to "at any time" waiting restrictions; and
  - (I) Change the existing single yellow line restrictions (no parking from 8am 6:30pm Mondays to Saturdays inclusive) in The Ride on the south-east side between a point 36 metres north-east the north-eastern kerb-line of Hertford Road, Enfield and a point 12.4 metres north-east of that point to "at any time" waiting restrictions.

# The Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. \*) Order 202\* Statement of Reasons

### **Barbot Close, N9**

Enfield Council is proposing double yellow lines at the southern end of Barbot Close.

The restrictions are being introduced in response to London Fire Brigade raising the issue of emergency access to the block of flats at the end of Barbot Close. Currently cars park on both sides of the road which makes road inaccessible for fire appliances.

## **Beech Close jw Woodstock Crescent, N9**

Enfield Council is proposing double yellow lines at the southern side of Beech Close as well extending the existing double yellow lines on the northern corner junction with Woodstock Crescent.

Currently vehicles park on the both sides of the road which regularly causes access issues to our waste collection teams. These measures will also ensure access for emergency vehicles is maintained at all times.

## **Byland Close, N21**

Enfield Council is proposing to extend the double yellow lines into Byland Close on the northern side of the road from the junction with The Glade.

The parking restrictions are being proposed in response to the issue of missed refuse collections and access for Dial-a-Ride buses. The proposed extension of double yellow lines will also help with emergency access.

## Hydefield Court (Keats Surgery entrance), N9

Enfield Council is proposing to extend the double yellow lines at the north-west end of Hydefield Court adjacent to the car park entrance for Keats GP Surgery.

The parking restrictions are being proposed as vehicle parking at this end of Hydefield Court affects access for larger emergency vehicles to the surgery car park.

#### **Nestor Avenue, N21**

Enfield Council is proposing to upgrade the single yellow lines on Nestor Avenue to double yellow lines.

The parking restrictions are being proposed to deal with the issue of parking on the both sides of the carriageway outside of the current 1-hour restriction making access for larger vehicles in particular emergency vehicles a problem.

#### Tasmania Terrace, N18

Enfield Council is proposing to implement double yellow lines on the southern side of Tasmania Terrace.

Currently vehicles park on the both sides of the road which regularly causes access issues to our waste collection teams. These measures will also ensure access for emergency vehicles is maintained at all times.

## The Ride (Howarth Building Supplies entrance), EN3

Enfield Council is proposing to upgrade the existing single yellow line on the southern side of The Ride as well as a short section on the northern side across the entrance to Howarth Building Supplies near the junction with the A1010 Hertford Road.

The parking of vehicles on the western end of The Ride is blocking delivery access for large vehicles to the building supplies business. Double yellow lines will also help with indiscriminate parking during school drop off and pick up times.
