

## QUEENSWAY AND HIGH STREET EN3 - TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in order to facilitate essential utility works on the roads detailed in the heading to this notice, the Council of the London Borough of Enfield have made the Enfield (Queensway and High Street EN3) (No.1) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2024 under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The effect of the Order will be to temporarily restrict traffic, as and when directed by traffic signs, in the streets specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Notice.
3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2 above will not apply to works vehicles or, if the works allow, to police or emergency services' vehicles.
4. The prohibitions will operate during the times and on the dates specified in column 2 of the Schedule in each case and will continue until the works are completed.
5. Whilst the prohibitions are in force, the alternative routes for diverted vehicles will be as stated in column 3 in each case.

<b>Queensway EN3</b> Road Closure – at its junction with High Street EN3, westwards for approximately 5 metres.	27 November 2024 for 2 days or until the works are completed.	Route 1: High Street EN3, Southbury Road and Kingsway.  Route 2: Kingsway, Lincoln Road, High Street EN3 and Vice Versa.
<b>High Street EN3</b> Northbound Cycle Lane Closure – from a point in line with the common boundary of Nos. 240/242 High Street EN3 to outside the common boundary of Nos. 250/252 High Street EN3.		Cyclists would be required to dismount and walk for the length of the cycle lane closure or join the main carriageway to continue cycling.
