What?

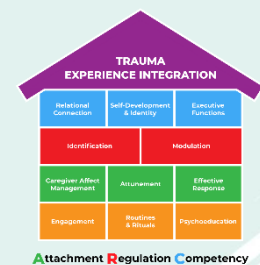
Cost?
