

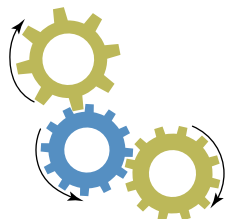
E-TIPSS EARLY YEARS DASHBOARD

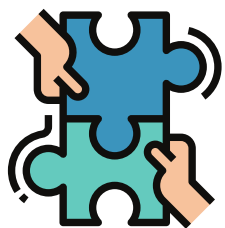
