STATEMENT OF REASONS

Cycle Parking in Enfield

Enfield Council is committed to encouraging more active travel and providing cycle parking provisions. The lack of secure, long-term cycle parking can deter people from using their bicycles. By providing secure cycle parking across the borough, the council aims to create an environment where residents can conveniently store and access their bicycles. Bike Hangars are a form of long-stay secure cycling parking, being implemented in various areas across Enfield to increase cycle parking capacity in residential streets and support the growth of active travel.

Enfield Council is proposing to install bike hangars in the following locations:

- Outside 27 The Limes Avenue, N11 1RD
- Outside 65 Russell Road, N13 4RP

The traffic management orders are necessary to implement the bike hangars listed above.

A statutory consultation was started on 9th October 2024, but there were errors contained in the consultation documentation. The Russell Road location plan was incorrect along with the consultation letters sent out to residents and other associated documentation contained clerical errors. This statutory consultation is therefore a rerun for similar proposals at the above-mentioned locations.

- 4. (1) Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order and, bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a width throughout of 1.83 metres is designated as a parking place.
- (2) The provisions of the Order of 1997 (other than Articles 3 and 15) shall apply to the areas designated as parking places by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place included a reference to an area designated as a parking place by this Order, as if any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 1997 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.
