
Application Procedure for Providers

The Disability Access Fund (DAF) is an annual payment of £615 available for any child of NEF age claiming Disability Living Allowance.

The fund is designed to support children with disabilities or special educational needs access early years places by supporting providers in making reasonable adjustments to their settings.

Applying for the DAF

In order to apply for the DAF for a child at your setting, please send a copy of the letter evidencing the child's eligibility to Disability Living Allowance to if@enfield.gov.uk. An example of the letter can be seen below.



Once the letter has been received the payment will be made to you.

A second payment will be made on the anniversary of the first payment if the child is still attending your setting and still NEF age.
