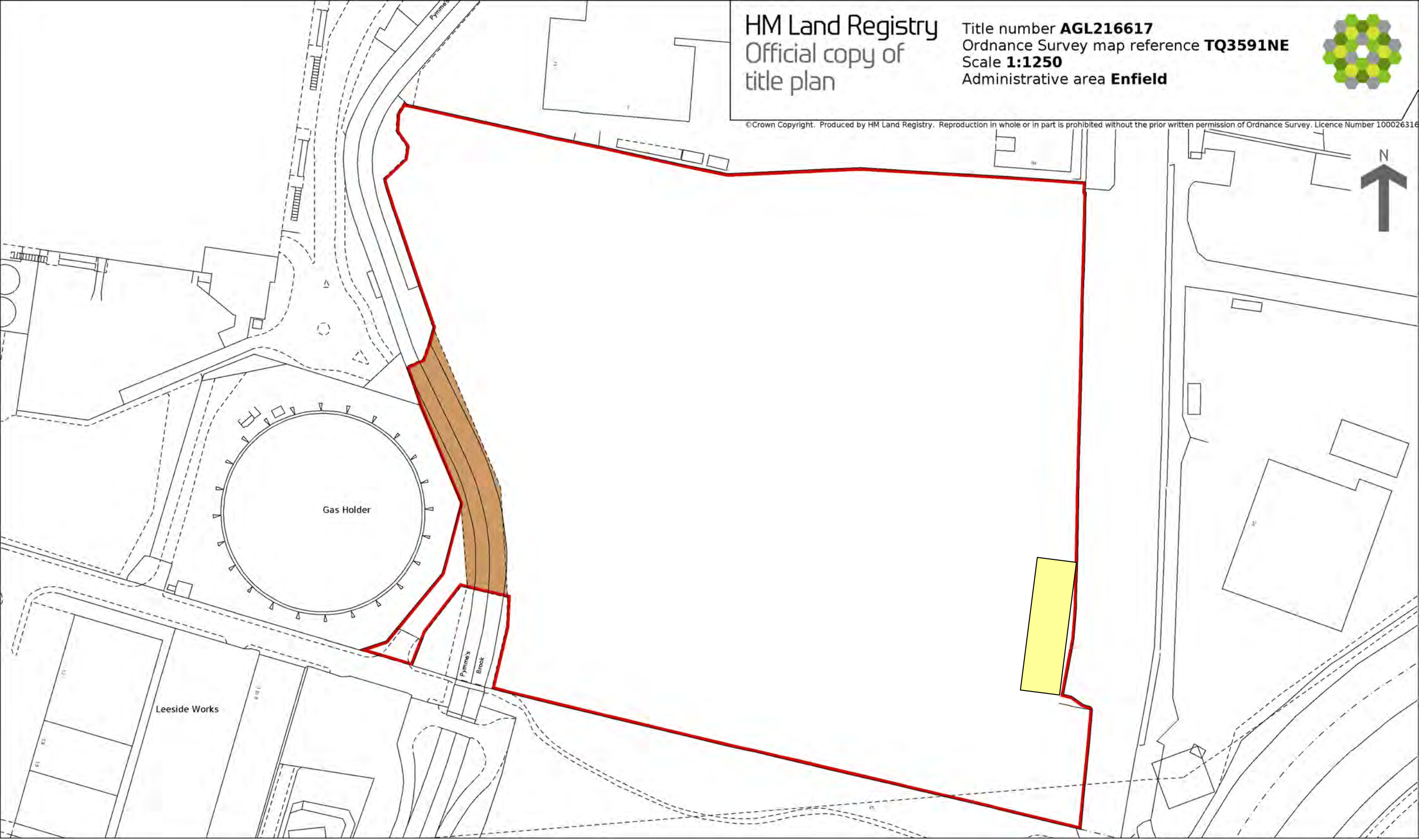

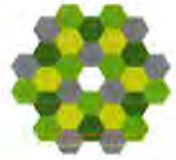

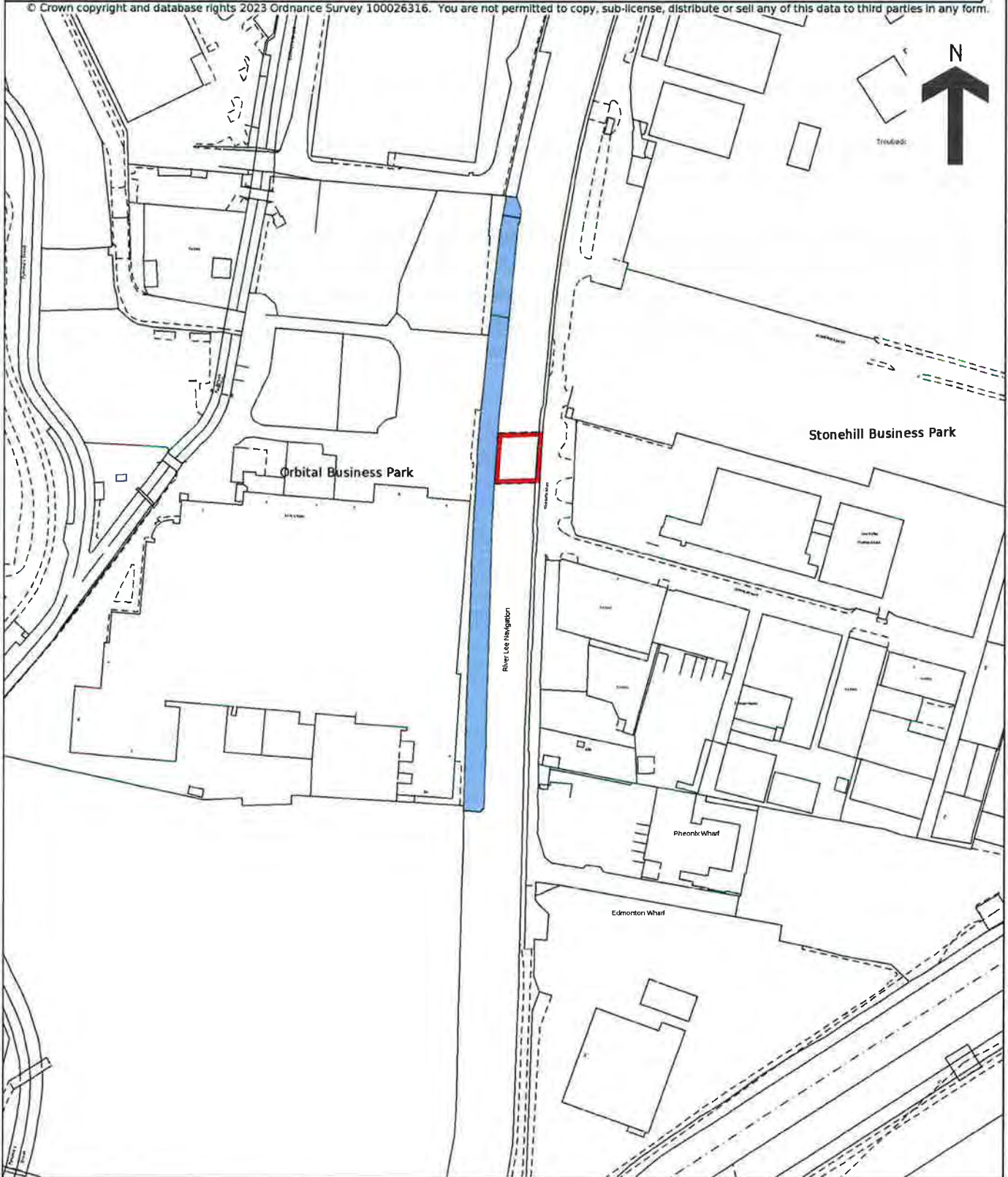

In accordance with clause 61.3 of the conditions of contract, I notify you of a compensation event.

We consider the compensation event type is:

- (2) Client does not allow access to and use of Site

The detail of this matter is:

There are illegal boaters present along the west bank of the River Lea Navigation Canal. See also Early Warning matters included in contract data part 2 and EW-15.

The Contractor needs access to this area in order to carry out vegetation clearance and surveys ahead of canal wall works and earthworks required by the Scope. As a part mitigation, the Contractor has proposed phased access to fence off, create ramps, and progress available areas.

The access date for the area required for vegetation clearance was the Starting Date of the contract (6th December 2023) referred to as "All Other Pink Land within the Boundaries of the Site". However, the actual access date is currently unknown until the illegal boaters and encroachments on to the canal bank are cleared.

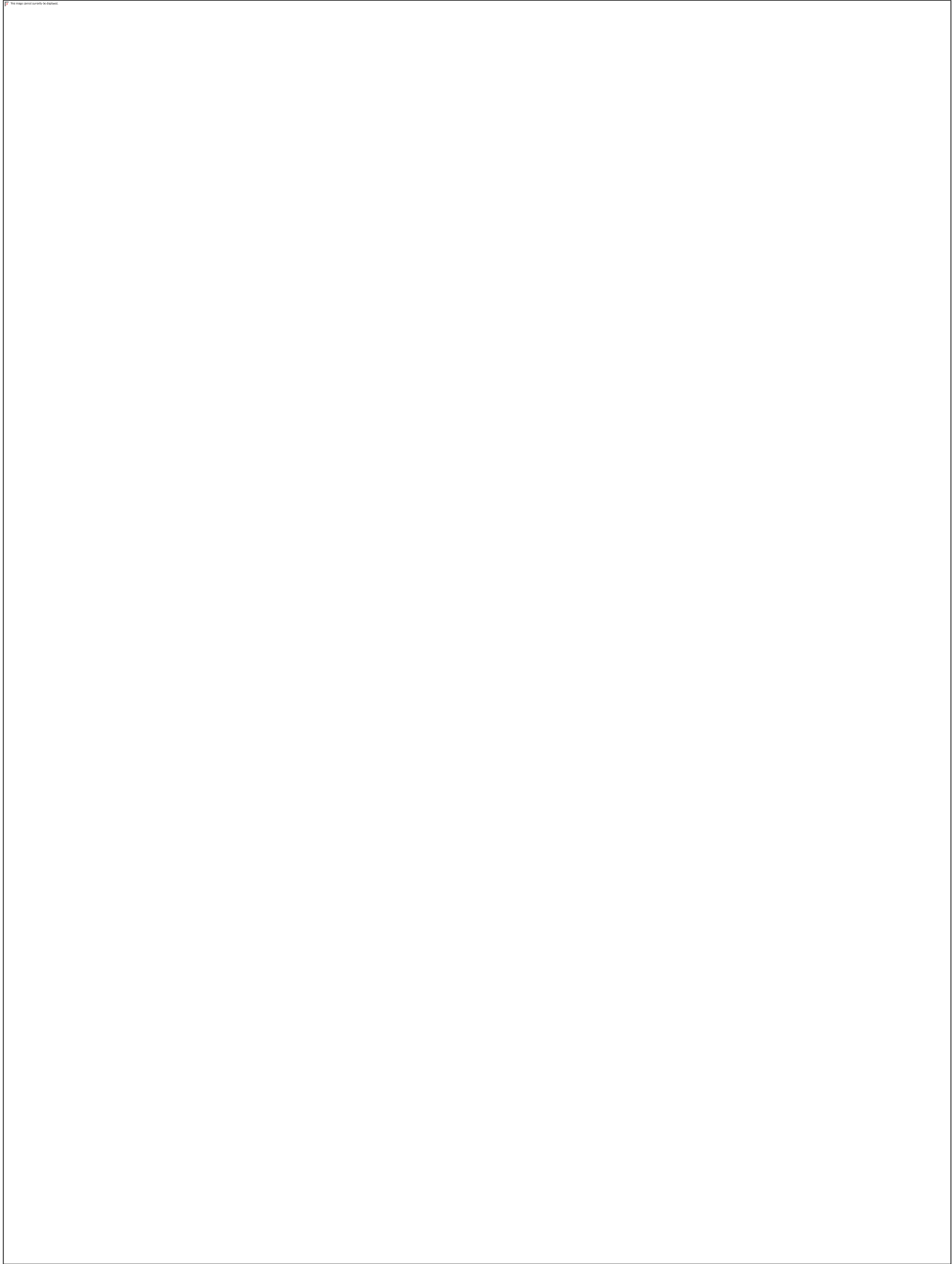

Dear Karen,

I am pleased to update that the mooring suspension notice was placed, on your behalf, along the offside land on Wednesday last week. To confirm, the Land Registry document show that the Trust owns all of the waterway in question, therefore this is how we are able to put a suspension in place as requested.

With regards to next steps, if the boats do not move from the moorings against the Council land, then it would be for the Council to take further action, given that they want them moved to carry out the works. Our legal team have advised that the Council could apply for a possession order (and injunction) to remove the boats.

We would like to ask what the Council's plans are, if the boats do not move, either following notices or after a possession order is granted, as we want to ensure that they remove the boats properly so as not to cause us any further problems. If for example, the plan was to merely cut ropes and let them drift into the waterway, this could cause problems for the Trust and would be an actionable nuisance.

Our legal team is happy to discuss the matter with the Councils legal team if they wish. With the Trusts experience and knowledge in this area of work, I believe this would be beneficial to the Council and I would be happy to arrange a call between the relevant people.

Lastly, the case I referred to over the phone was not a case law, it was a situation we had with an improperly moored boat at Dead Dogs basin, Camden. I shared this example to demonstrate the difficulties in relocating one individual and their home. We were able to support the relocation from third-party land, in this situation, as the planned works were taking place on Trust land. Given that the works due to take place at Enfield are on third party land, we are not in the same position and would not be able to support with the physical relocation or removal of the boats. However, our legal team would be happy to discuss and share the Trust's approach to managing this type of situation, to aid the Council in their approach. We can also share the commercial contacts the Trusts hold to support the Council in managing boat removals.

We will continue to address the improper mooring on the offside through our legal licence processes. As you know, these processes are not quick, especially when the boats are liveaboard. Therefore, if you require the boats to move on more quickly, to meet the planned works deadline in February, the Trusts advice is for the Council to apply for a possession order (and injunction) to remove the boats.

Please find attached a plan of boats on each embankment, the yellow line on the plan denotes the area that is currently part of the wider engineering works programme that we need cleared (i.e. no vessels on either side)

Most importantly Simon has helpfully located the boaters on an ariel plan view (first image) to which I have added yellow arrows top and bottom and a yellow line showing the extent of TW's site and access requirement. This is the extent of TW's site and where they require access as of now to clear vegetation and debris. The engineering works to the canal wall are scheduled to start on 28th February. The contract dates are 6th December 2023 to 31st March 2026.
