

GREEN LANES N21 - TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in order to facilitate essential utility works Green Lanes N21, the Council of the London Borough of Enfield have made the Enfield (Green Lanes N21) (No.1) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2024 under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit cyclists from entering or proceeding on the northbound and southbound cycle lanes from its junction with Radcliffe Road to outside No.805, Green Lanes N21.
3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2 above will not apply to works vehicles or, if the works allow, to police or emergency services vehicles.
4. The prohibitions will come into operation on 8 July 2024 and will continue in force for 5 days or until works are completed.
5. Whilst the prohibitions are in operation cyclists will be required to dismount and walk or rejoin the main carriageway to cycle.
