Coming into operation .....see Article 1

The Council of the London Borough of Enfield, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 29 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the dates and times specified in the schedule to this order and may be cited as the Enfield (Play Street Restrictions) (No.1) Order 2025.
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any street or part of a street specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order on the dates and times specified in Schedule 2 in relation thereto.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply in relation to a vehicle -
  - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - (b) being used in the service of a statutory undertaker in an emergency;
  - (c) needing to gain access to or leave any land or premises abutting thereon or accessible only therefrom;

4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
