## UK Parliamentary election

1. An Election is to be held for a Member of Parliament to serve Edmonton and Winchmore Hill constituency.

Nominations papers must be delivered to the (Acting) Returning Officer at Electoral Services Office, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Civic Centre, Silver Street, EN1 3XA on any day after the date of this notice , on Monday to Friday 10am to 4pm (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4pm on Friday 7 June 2024.

New applications to vote by post, and amendments or cancellations of existing postal votes or proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Electoral Services Office, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Civic Centre, Silver Street, EN1 3XA by 5pm on **Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2024.** Applications can be made online at **www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote.**

8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on **Wednesday 26 June 2024**.
