

## **AUTUMN CLOSE EN1 – NEW ‘AT ANY TIME’ WAITING RESTRICTIONS.**

**1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Enfield (the Council) on 12 June 2024 made the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 248) Order 2024 under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

**2.** The general effect of the Order will be to introduce new “at any time” waiting restrictions in Autumn Close EN1, on the west side extending the existing restrictions at its junction with Carterhatch Lane.

**4.** Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

Statement of Reasons

Autumn Close, EN1

Enfield Council is proposing to extend the double yellow lines at the southern end of Autumn Close on the western kerbline by 30m. In addition, we are proposing School Keep Clear road markings between 36 and 46 Autumn Close. The hours of operation of these markings will be Monday to Friday (8:30-9:30am and 2:30-3:30pm).

The restrictions are being introduced to prevent indiscriminate parking by parents dropping off and collecting their children at adjacent schools on Autumn Close. The parking also causes major access and egress issues for the Council mini-buses that bring the Special Educational Needs children to Russet House school.

The Council of the London Borough of Enfield, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 24 June 2024 and may be cited as the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 248) Order 2024.
2. In this Order the expression “enactment” means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2012(b) shall have effect as though for the item numbered 473 (Autumn Close) in Schedule 1 to that Order there were substituted the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of the Schedule to this Order.
