Statement of Reasons

Cocker Road, EN1

Enfield Council is proposing to introduce double yellow lines on the bend of Cocker Road in the vicinity of 40 Cocker Road

The parking of vehicles at this location is causing access issues for refuse collection vehicles.

Ridings Avenue, The Chine and Old Park Ridings, N21

Enfield Council is proposing to install double yellow lines at the junctions of Ridings Avenue and The Chine at their junctions with Old Park Ridings

The parking of vehicles at these two junctions is causing visibility issues for residents exiting from these side roads onto Old Park Ridings.

Calshot Way, EN2

Enfield Council is proposing to introduce double yellow lines on the bend of Calshot Way outside 14 Calshot Way.

The parking of vehicles at this location is causing access issues for refuse collection vehicles.

Yeomans Way, EN3

Enfield Council is proposing to introduce double yellow lines on the bend of Yeomans Way at the entrance to 1-68 Yeomans Way. In addition, two short sections of double yellow lines are proposed at dropped kerb access for commercial bin collection points

The parking of vehicles at this location is causing access issues for refuse collection vehicles as well access points for bin collections.

Palmers Lane and Lytchet Way, EN3

Enfield Council is proposing to introduce double yellow lines on the south side of Palmers Lane from the junction with Lytchet Way up to the existing double yellow lines opposite the junction with Roedean Avenue.

The parking of vehicles at this location is causing access issues for refuse collection vehicles.

Bycullah Road and Shanti Close, EN2

Enfield Council is proposing to introduce double yellow lines adjacent to the entrance to Shanti Close on Bycullah Road as well as double yellow lines on Shanti Close (Housing land)

The restrictions are being introduced to allow Enfield Council refuse vehicles to safely reverse into Shanti Close for waste collection.

The Council of the London Borough of Enfield, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 2 December 2024 and may be cited as the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 260) Order 2024.
- 2. In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2012(b) shall have effect as though
 - (i) for the items numbered 1242 (Bycullah Road), 1330 (Calshot Way), 1453 (Cocker Road), 604 (Old Park Ridings), 365 (Palmers Lane), 598 (The Chine) and 454 (Yeoman's Way) in Schedule 1 to that Order there were substituted the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order; and

(ii) there were added to Schedule 1 to that Order the item numbered 178 (Lytchet Way), 179 (Ridings Avenue) and 180 (Shanti Close) set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 2 to this Order.
