DECLARATION

By signing and submitting this notification, the producer/informant agrees to ensure and adhere to the following:

- 1. No payment will be made to the child or anyone else, on behalf of the child, other than for defraying expenses. No other party should make a financial gain as a result of the performance.
- 2. No child will be absent from school to take part in the performance unless written permission has been obtained from the child's school (This must be a document on school headed paper/bearing the school stamp/an email from an official school email address)
- 3. The producer will ensure that an appropriate number of suitable adults (preferably approved chaperones and/or DBS Enhanced cleared adults) are engaged to care for the children employed, having specific regard to their sex and age, ensuring that each child is supervised at all times.
- 4. The producer will ensure that a list of emergency contact details in respect of each child including any medical issues or additional needs is available at the place of performance.
- 5. A first aider is present at the performance.
- 6. The producer will ensure that no child taking part in the performance/activity has performed for more than 3 days in the past 6 months. This includes licensed performances, unlicensed performances (Exemptions) and performances under Body Of Persons Approval.
- 7. The organisation agrees to comply with Regulation 11 and Regulations 15 to 29 of The Children (Performances and Activities) (England) Regulations 2014.
- 8. The producer agrees to any authorised officer of the Local Authority having unrestricted access whilst any dress or technical rehearsal or performance is taking place at any venue that the producer uses for such purposes.

In signing this declaration, you agree to the terms and conditions above.

Failure to comply with Children & Young Persons Act 1963 s.37 and The Children (Performances and Activities) (England) Regulations 2014 is a criminal offence, which on conviction carries a maximum penalty of £1,000 or three months imprisonment or both, for each offence.
