 - (a) Introduce permanent "at any time" waiting restrictions on Alma Road EN3 from a point 8 metres south-west of the southern flank wall of No.137 Alma Road EN3, southwards for a distance of 88 metres on both sides of the carriageway; and
 - (b) Extend the existing "at any time" waiting restrictions on the south-eastern extent of the main carriageway of the south-east to north-west arm of Devonshire Road.

The Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. *) Order 202*

Statement of Reasons

Alma Road, EN3

Enfield Council is proposing to keep recently introduced parking restrictions in Alma Road. The double yellow lines are from a point 8 metres southwest of the southern flank wall of No. 137 Alma Road, EN3 southwards for a distance of 88 metres.

The restrictions were introduced in response to the Emergency Services raising the issue of emergency access and TfL busses having to divert bus route 191. Vehicles were parking on both sides of the road obstructing access especially for larger vehicles. At times this part of Alma Road was inaccessible for fire appliances, buses and other large vehicles. A Temporary Traffic Management Order was made in November 2024 and this Traffic Order is being proposed to make those restrictions permanent.

Devonshire Road, N13

Enfield Council is proposing a short length of double yellow lines at the south-eastern extent of the main carriageway of the south-east to north-west arm of Devonshire Road.

On the 21st February 2024, Devonshire Road was closed between its junction with Green Lanes and a point 2 metres south-east of a point in line with the common boundary of Nos. 399 and 399c Green Lanes. The proposal is to join up the double yellow lines on either side of Devonshire Road at its most south-easterly point. This is proposed:

- To formalise the existing parking arrangements on Devonshire Road, so as to make it clear that drivers shouldn't be parking perpendicular to the kerb at the end of the road and aid enforcement of the existing restrictions;
- Encourage improved health and well-being through enabling more people, particularly
 the young, older and other groups less likely to cycle, to travel actively (e.g. walking or
 cycling) in the area, by making it safer and easier to do so;
- Help reduce traffic dominance in the area, thereby over time reducing pollution and congestion; and
- Contribute to delivering key London-wide strategies, such as the Mayor's Transport Strategy.
