What are the different types of activities being delivered from Enfield Children's Centre sites?

Children's Centre activities are activities delivered directly by Enfield Children's Centre staff and include things like Stay and Play sessions, First Time Parents Programme and Let's Play sessions.

Partner organisations also delivers activities from Children's Centre sites which include things like the Healthy Child Clinics delivered by the Health Visiting Service and Speech and Language Sessions delivered by the Speech and Language Therapy Service.
