

CHANGES TO OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES IN CENTRE WAY, SOUTH WAY AND MARSH HOUSE (NO. 500) MONTAGU ROAD N9 AND REVOCATION OF WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS IN THE ACCESS ROAD TO THE REAR OF NOS. 18 – 38 CAPEL ROAD EN1

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Enfield ('the Council') have made the Enfield (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2024, and the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Amendment No. 252) Order 2024 under sections 6, 32, 33, 35 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the 1984 Act'), as amended.
- 2.** The general effect of the Orders which come into operation on 26 June 2024 will be:
 - (a)** to revoke designated off-street permit holder parking places in the Claverings Estate:
 - (1) Centre Way N9
 - (2) South Way N9
 - (3) Montagu Road N9 at No. 500 Marsh House
 - (b)** to revoke waiting and loading restrictions from the Access Road to the rear of Nos. 18 to 38 Capel Road EN1.

- 5.** Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

Statement of Reasons

Claverings Estate, N9

Enfield Council is proposing to remove all off-street permit holder parking places in the Claverings Estate (Centre Way N9, South Way N9 and at No.500 Marsh House Montagu Road N9) by revocation of the relevant Traffic Management Order. This is being undertaken for the sake of due process, to accord with the Councils decision to dispose of the relevant lands, which will then pass into private ownership.

The Access Road to the rear of Nos. 18 – 38 Capel Road, EN1

Enfield Council is proposing to remove waiting and loading restrictions from The Access Road to the rear of Nos. 18 – 38 Capel Road, EN1 by revocation of the relevant Traffic Management Order. This is being undertaken for the sake of due process, to accord with the Councils decision to dispose of the relevant garages and associated land, which will pass into private ownership.

Made 26 June 2024

Coming into operation 26 June 2024

The Council of the London Borough of Enfield, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 32, 33, 35 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order shall come into operation on 26 June 2024 and may be cited as the Enfield (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2024.

Interpretation

2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Enfield (Off-Street Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 2015(b) shall have effect as though:
 - a) in Article 3 of that order the definitions of “Claverings parking permit” and “Claverings Schedule” were omitted.
 - b) Articles 3(4) and 10a, Articles 36, 37, 38 and 39 under the heading “Application for and issue of Claverings parking permits for use in Claverings parking places”; Article 40 under the heading “Refund of fee paid in respect of a Claverings parking permit”, Article 41 under the

heading "Surrender, withdrawal and validity of Claverings parking permit", Article 42 under the heading "Application for and issue of Claverings parking permits" and Articles 43 and 44 under the heading "Form of Claverings parking permit" were omitted.

- c) for Article 11 and the associated heading there were substituted the following Article and heading:

"Vouchers or season tickets to be displayed on vehicle left in a parking place


11. At all times whilst a vehicle, other than a solo motorcycle or a vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position is left in a parking place listed in Schedule 1 to this Order:

(a) it shall display in a conspicuous position either a valid voucher or season ticket issued in accordance with the provisions of Article 14 or 25 respectively, so that all the particulars on that season ticket or permit, as the case may be, are readily visible from outside that vehicle; or

(b) payment of the parking charge in respect of that vehicle shall be indicated by the appearance on a hand-held device of an indication that the parking charge has been paid and accepted in respect of that vehicle and in respect of the parking place in which the vehicle is left and an indication that the parking period for which payment of that parking charge has been made and accepted has not expired."

- d) for the Parking Place numbered 21. Claverings Estate in the Schedule to that Order there were substituted the item similarly numbered and set out in columns 1, 2,3 and 4 of the Schedule to this Order.

The Council of the London Borough of Enfield, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 26 June 2024 and may be cited as the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. *) Traffic Order 2024.
2. In this Order the expression “enactment” means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred before the coming into operation of this Order, the Enfield (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 238) Traffic Order 2023 is hereby revoked.
