Whilst I appreciate that due to housing targets set by Central Government, that more housing is 'required' in Enfield I object to the current tower block proposal at Cockfosters for the following reasons;

It is not in keep with the local area existing low rise architecture.

It is next to Trent Park and local greenbelt and at approximately 45m high it will be an eyesore to the local area.

This will not be affordable housing, it is a prime locations with high land prices.
