None of our green belt should be built on. This should be protected at at all costs. Climate change requires us to preserve our green areas and natural bio diversity but also protect us from flooding. Which happens as a result of overdevelopment of our natural green areas.

These massive housing estates will not solve the housing problem, as the developers always make sure that profit is put before people. We need affordable decent houses with gardens that encourage people to invest in their environment not like the Chase Farm development, which was aimed at the affluent.

Also COVID must be taken into account, with people moving outside of London and needing more green spaces, not fewer.

Sadly, I don't trust Enfield Council with this long term decision making and to plan the required infrastructure properly.
