1 .I have lived in Hadley Wood for 59 years. I was born in Duchy Road in 1962.

I am a member of the Hadley Wood Association.

- 2. At present Hadley Wood is being massively over developed and this concreting of green space is hugely affecting the water table in the area. There has been flooding from Camlet Way home into homes in Crescent East.
- 3 Hadley Wood is a village with a small parade of shops and an overground station that goes into the City or into Welwyn. Only 2 to 3 trains an hour.

There is 1 bus an hour that runs backwards and forwards only to Barnet.

4. This area is not equipped to have another 160 homes with in excess of another probably 500 people.

The roads around the proposed development cannot cope with the excess traffic.

- 5. Hadley Wood would not be an area for affordable homes and there are plenty brownfield sites that should be developed first.
- 6. The fields are part of what gives Hadley Wood its beauty and space, I regularly walk around the fields and it is very important that the inhabitants of Hadley Wood have this open space, after all this is why most people have settled here.
- 7. The Enfield planning department appear not to care as proven by the amount of houses that have been knocked down and rebuilt not in character with the area and also the over development of flats. If you do not live here, how can you

appreciate how very special Hadley Wood is if you don't even live here?

8. The land is owned by the Duchy of Lancaster who advocates for maintaining Green Belt and believes in conservation. How very hypocritical to only be selling off this land for pure financial gain and to only develop houses. There are far better places to be developing 160 new

affordable homes.

9. Hadley Wood is surrounded by Hadley Wood Conservation Area and by Monkey Hadley Conservation Area there are also Grade II listed buildings on Camlet Way. There would be massive detrimental impact on the setting and character of the surrounding area if 160 homes were built

on this site.

I STRONGLY OBJECT TO THIS DEVELOPMENT AND HOPE YOU HAVE THE GOOD SENSE TO FIND ANOTHER AREA TO BUILD THE 160 NEW HOMES.
