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Sir or Madam,

I object to the aspects of the draft Local Plan as detailed below:

Policy SP PL 10, pages 80-87, and figure 3.11; Policy SP PL9, pages 77-80 and Concept Plan Figure 3.10; SA45, page 364; SA52 page 372; SA54, page 374.

Building of houses or other structures on land that is currently Green Belt or agricultural land is unnecessary as there are sufficient 'brown field' and former retail or industrial sites that could be developed. The destruction of any of the green belt, which is Enfield Borough's most precious resource, is to be avoided at all costs.

Such development is contrary to local, national and international efforts to combat climate change.

SA62 page 383 and SP CL pages 277-279.

Any further expansion of the Spurs training facility in Whitewebbs Park should not be permitted. This is not an appropriate use of public land gifted to Enfield Council for the benefit of local residents. In addition Spurs have not fulfilled previous environmental commitments linked to the original development of their training ground including working with Capel Manor to create a nature reserve.

Policy DE6 pages 156-160 and SA2 Palace Gardens Shopping Centre page 321.

Tall buildings, higher than those already in place, should not be permitted in sensitive locations such as the Town Centre Conservation Area as this will overshadow and spoil the appearance of the area.
