In relation to section 2.4 of the plan.

I object to proposals to build on green belt land.

I object to proposals to build 93,000 new houses in a 'sustainable settlement' at Crews Hill with the potential for longer term expansion up to 7,500 new homes. (Policy SP PL9, pages 77-80 and Concept Plan Figure 3.10); All my life I have enjoyed and benefitted from being able to visit the crews hill garden centres will the feeling gives of getting away from suburbia and also being able to use it to improve my own garden. The very fact that it is not highly sophisticated is what makes it attractive.

I object to the encouragement for tall buildings, especially in sensitive locations such as the town centre conservation area (see pages 156-60, Figure 7.3, Figure 7.4 and Policy DE6, and SA2 Palace Gardens Shopping centre page 321). The buildings put up in Southbury Road have already blocked out sunlight to pedestrians, and the new office block near Genetin terrace is far to near the road. Tall buildings are not only hazardous but block out the sky which is so important for our psychological well being. Don't we ever learn!!

I also object to any building development on Whitewebbs Park or any proposals that would stop members of the public being able to freely roam across the area including the woods and lake area where I get a great deal of pleasure including watching the terrapin wild foul water lillies etc.
