Dear Enfield Council,

I am a local resident of Cockfosters just on the Enfield/Barnet border and am appalled to see that in the draft Enfield plan the Greenbelt is up for development. I think this is a terrible mistake and will alter the area (especially Hadley Wood) for the worse.

Therefore I am writing to object to the following Policies: SP PL10, pages 80-87, and Figure 3.11; Policy SP PL9, pages 77-80 and Concept Plan Figure 3.10; Policy SA45: Land Between Camlet Way and Crescent Way, Hadley Wood, page 364; Policy SA54, page 374; and Policy SA62 page 383 and SP CL4 pages 277-279 – all these policies propose the dedesignation of Green Belt land for housing and other purposes.

These sites are unique & historic areas in the southeast part of the borough and played an important role in the development of Enfield. It is a rare and valuable landscape asset and its loss would cause permanent harm not only to the Green Belt, but also to the very character of the borough and local area.

The rest of the local plan is no better and I do not accept that the other areas of the Greenbelt in Enfield need to be developed eg. Vicarage Farm (Chase Park) or Crews Hill. Also the encouragement of high rise development will create a ghetto type area in Enfield. Just awful!
