I am writing to object to the following Policies:

I cannot believe that the council are proposing that it is acceptable to build on green belt land

Loss of the above green belt will cause permanent harm to the green belt, it's landscape and our Borough as a whole. I have lived in the borough my whole life. The most attractive feature is that it's a London borough with green belt. I live right next to green belt land and I would be absolutely outraged if the green belt was built upon and would ruin the lovely area I live in. Not only would it cause a rise in traffic, pollution etc but there are literally no where and no schools for the people proposed to live in these houses.

I also object to Policies SA62 page 383 and SP CL4 pages 277-279 because they transfer part of Whitewebbs Park, a public amenity, into private management. I reject the Council's analysis that Whitewebbs Golf Course was losing money and call for its reinstatement.

I am also objecting to Policy SA52 page 372, which would remove part of Rammey Marsh, a wildlife area and public amenity, from the Green Belt.

I am also objecting to the tall building policies on pages 156-160, Figure 7.3, Figure 7.4 and Policy DE6, and SA2 Palace Gardens Shopping Centre page 321 which propose areas for and the acceptable height of tall buildings which, would completely ruin the landscape. The town is already far behind other towns and doing this will only ruin it further

Not only do I live in Enfield but also work here and frankly I am ashamed of the council for even proposing this.

I can not express how much I oppose these proposals. You are ruining the Borough
