I wish to register my objection to Enfield Council's draft local plan.

The plan needlessly threatens the Green Belt by unwanted and unnecessary development. I understand the need to build new homes, but there are plenty of brownfield sites in Enfield which can be reused and recycled. These sites have not been properly considered in the plan. Instead the preferred options are for developer-led solutions focused on expensive executive homes destroying environmentally and historically important green belt land.
