I wish to make following reason for objection :

Firs Farm is a widely used local amenity and is an important part in mitigating against climate change. It's very accessible to those with disabilities. Additional traffic/parking/ pollution would negatively impact local residents already affected by A10.

Also the loss of valuable green space and additional dangerously high emissions (to power and run a crematorium) so close to schools and residents. There could also be the risk of water contamination with a crematorium on such a site. Not a progressive approach to climate change at all.
