## **Dear Sirs**

I am writing to object to the following policies within your draft local plan as follows:

SP PL10, pages 80-87, and Figure 3.11; Policy SP PL9, pages 77-80 and Concept Plan Figure 3.10; Policy SA45: Land Between Camlet Way and Crescent Way, Hadley Wood, page 364; Policy SA54, page 374; and Policy SA62 page 383 and SP CL4 pages 277-279 – all of these propose the dedesignation of Green Belt for housing and other purposes.

These sites are part of the historic Enfield Chase, which is unique in the southeast and has played an important role in the development of Enfield as a 'green and pleasant' borough in which to live. The greenbelt Enfield Chase is a valuable and an irreplaceable landscape asset and its loss would cause permanent harm not only to the Green Belt as a whole, but also to the very character of the borough, as well as the neighbouring borough of Barnet.

Also I understand the dedesignation of more than really small areas of greenbelt is strongly discouraged by the Mayor of London.

I will fight against any planning development within these sites as our precious greenbelt needs to be protected, for us and for future generations.
