I object in the strongest terms to the proposed housing development of part of Sainsburys Green Lanes N21, onto which my property backs. Such a development would not only blight the area, but would also breach the binding conditions agreed by Sainsburys before developing the property in the first place. It remains my understanding that Sainsburys was only authorised to develop the property on condition that 40% would not only remain "green belt", but would actually be landscaped, carefully protecting all healthy trees. I am not qualified to state the precise legal terms of reference of said condition, which your own Legal Department can obviously do when you consult them, as i trust you will.
