Having read the plan I am of the view it is not fit for purpose, it lacks vision and any apparent understanding of the unique qualities of the borough. In particular:

No to the Crematorium - I question the need for another crematorium in Enfield, no clear case has been made in the document for more cremation capacity.

No to Green belt development - The council's intention to build on the green belt is appalling, robbing future generations of this irreplaceable resource. The council's failure to appreciate the importance of the green belt to people growing up in the east of the borough as I did is particularly galling. Having down scaled the Meridian Water in a transparent attempt to justify building on green belt land shows a particularly high level of contempt both for the people of the borough and the actual facts.

Please record my objections against the Local plan.
