I do not live in your borough but I regularly make use of land & facilities situated in your borough and am horrified by some of the ideas contained in your local plan. I particularly object to the possible loss of large areas of Green Belt land in the plan. I realise that the local plan has been developed in response to housing targets imposed on Enfield Council by City Hall (and, ultimately, Central Government), but you have not listened at all to the words of our current London Mayor, Sadiq Khan, who is vehemently opposed to the loss of Green Belt land.

There are a number of parts of the plan that involve Green Belt land, i.e. SA54 P 374 re Junction 24 of the M25, SA 62 P 383 and SP CL4 Pp 277-279 re Whitewebbs Lane/M25 & SP PL 9 Pp 77-80 Concept Plan Fig. 3.10 re Crews Hill to identify a few.

These green spaces are invaluable to the lives of those living inside and outside the boundaries of Enfield. Nurseries, a golf course, country walks, wonderful views, lack of congestion, wildlife, beautiful flowers, shrubs & trees, FRESH AIR!!!

Listen to your London Mayor. No to using Green Belt for development. Save our wonderful natural facilities and way of life. Invest in the future of our young people by not destroying the wonderful Green Belt. Make better use of the areas more fit for housing. Upgrade what we have got, not use the few remaining wide open spaces to in the borough that bring so much pleasure to many
