I strongly object to draft policy DMBG16 as a site for a burial ground/or cremation ground because;

Firs Farm is essential for the well being of local people.

It will significantly affect Nature conservation and several other policies in the local draft.

It will reduce effectiveness of flood alleviation.

It will effect the environment and local traffic.

It introduces uncertainly to the future use of Firs Farm.

Me and my neighbours certainly do not want to look out of the window every morning to see a crematorium and smell fumes from dead burnt bodies, which will effect ours and our families mental wellbeing

This is an utterly shocking idea of Enfield Council to have put this forward.

It would make sense to extend the cemetery and not to put a crematorium right in the middle of this well preserved land which the public have been using for decades.

For these reasons I call the council to remove all reference to Firs Farm wetlands from policy SP CL4.
