The wetlands is a green space widely used and loved by the community. It promotes wildlife and improves the local environment, as well as reducing the risk of floods.

This space is used for exercise, leisure, it helps improve mental health and is a safe place for children to play. It is not a space for a crematorium.

It is quite disgusting that it could even be considered to put something with such a harmful impact on pollution and the environment in an area with three schools surrounding.

This policy needs to be removed to protect green spaces in London and protect the wellbeing of our community and the young children put at risk.
