Hadley woods green belt areas are treasured among all its residents. The green belt land is a vast habitat for different creatures and the thought of destroying such a unique heritage landscape which we all cherish is unacceptable. It goes against green and climate change policies which are imperative to our planet to help tackle global warming. This land helps with air quality but also the biodiversity of the area.
