I object to draft policy DM BG16 in the Draft Enfield Local Plan. There was a big disappointment when I heard about the council's proposal to build a crematorium at Firs Farm Park.

I call the Council to give up the idea of building a crematorium and destroying the place which was made by inhabitants with love.
