> I wish to object to your proposed plan to place a crematorium in Firs Farm N13 open space and recently created Wetlands. > This is an open space for families and children for recreation including football and tennis in the wetlands and surrounding fields. > On the other side of the road is Winchmore School with their sports fields, along with Southgate Olympic FC and Northampton Exiles cricket club, who utilise Clowes sports ground which is directly opposite the proposed > Winchmore children use Firs Lane to walk to school and should not be put at risk with the large amount of traffic this would bring, and all surrounding roads have traffic speed bumps! > The area already has extra traffic created by Barrowell Green recycling centre, which causes traffic congestion in this area. > The area is residential with two large primary schools and Winchmore Comprehensive School within a few hundred yards of Firs Farm. > The extra traffic fumes and the emissions from crematorium would make this an extremely unhealthy environment for residents to live and for children who attend the local schools. > Enfield Council have recently installed new tennis courts within 100 metres of the proposed site to assist the local residents with their health and well-being. > How then is it possible to propose a crematorium to be situated within yards of a health facility. > A largely residential area should not be considered appropriate for a crematorium and extra traffic when considering the Health and Safety of residents and school children in the area surrounding Firs Lane. > Residents and schools should be considered before a proposed crematorium. > Thank you in advance for reconsideration of this proposal. >
