I wish to register my opposition to the proposal in the Draft Local Plan, the placemaking vision and associated Strategic Policy SP PL10: the 'Chase Park' development.

The land indicated has for nearly a hundred years performed precisely the role that its Green Belt designation envisaged - preventing the onward and outward sprawl of suburbia and providing ready access for many Enfield residents to a place of quiet enjoyment, decent air and natural environment. Notwithstanding the incorporation of blue/green corridors, the Chase Park proposal, especially at a density higher than neighbouring development, cannot possibly 'facilitate access to the rural landscape' as claimed in the placemaking vision. Except perhaps for the residents of the proposed new development itself - a proposition that could surely apply to pretty much any greenfield development anywhere.
