I oppose your plans to build a Crematorium on the wetlands. Whilst you say the proposal is to build the crematorium on the old car park, the plans show a vast area of the wetlands being utilized.

I regularly meet friends at the wetlands to walk our dogs. During the pandemic I used it to meet family and friends at a distance.

I am a widow and feel safer walking and playing with my dog at the wetlands than walking him around the now eerily quiet LTN roads off Bourne Hill where I live. Grovelands Park whilst once busy at weekends is very over populated at all times of the day.

I also went on the Welling Being Centre monthly walk and talk met ups in the wetlands and looked forward to the cafe being built.

The impact on the local community, the additional pollution as as a direct result of the Crematorium output to children at the local primary and secondary schools has not been taken into consideration. Firs lane is very busy during the day especially between 8 - 9.30 and between 3- 6pm.
