I have lived in Hadley Wood for 28 years. My children are 26, 23 and 18 and have grown up enjoying the area we live in, including many bike rides, walks with the dogs, picnics etc. This is not an area to mess with, to spoil the beauty and independence it has. Passing traffic has mounted over the years and so has the insecurity hence needing 24 hour security. The area is overpopulated as it is and cannot handle anything more than is already being overdeveloped.

The green belt of this area is a major asset for the borough and should be protected.

The problems we have already with the clay in the gardens and the flooding will just be excelled over and above the limit if this goes ahead.

There is poor transport in this area and the area you plan to build on is further away from buses and trains which will have a detrimental affect on the sale of any such properties and the congregation of more 'estate' roads will cause property prices to go down and change the whole meaning of the area.

It is unbelievable that the site is being considered at all.
