I would like to object to the local plan specifically in relation to:

- 1 The council should only build the housing numbers specifically required by Government. LB Enfield is a crowded borough already, if anything we should reducing housing numbers. If the Council needs to meet the minimum government targets then that is what we should do and no more
- 2. I object to the use of Sainsbury's Winchmore Hill for Housing SA32 on the grounds that losing a busy local supermarket will mean more people travelling by car to other locations hence increasing pollution and congestion, it is a valuable local amenity, we will lose parking spaces for other local shops as it is an easy walk into Winchmore Hill Broadway ( and we are losing further spaces from Forde Grove).
