Objection - Site SA45 (Land between Camlet Way and Crescent West, Hadley Wood) and Intensification Zone around Hadley Wood station

I have moved into Hadley Wood at the beginning of 2021.

I was drawn to the area as it is surrounded by the Green Belt, which provides the special character of the area. I value all the green spaces within Hadley wood and I therefore object to the proposed site allocation which would allow the development of 160 homes on Green Belt land.

The green belt must be protected and conserved as it serves vital purposes, helping air quality in the borough and biodiversity. The grasslands are an important resources for carbon sequestration.

Hadley wood is a car dependent location and key roads operate at over 100% of capacity. Congestion causes pollution and building of huge nos of houses in this area will only make situation worse.
