

I am writing to object to page 351 of the Enfield local plan which will see Sainsbury's green lanes knocked down.

The loss of a major supermarket in the area will see people have to drive further at a time when we are trying to reduce our carbon footprints. There are not comparable supermarkets to Sainsbury's Green Lanes within easy reach of Winchmore Hill and so people will have to drive more.

No supporting community infrastructure is planned which will be problematic for schools and doctors surgeries - Winchmore Hill Practice at 808 Green Lanes is already struggling to cope having been merged with another doctors in Palmers Green.

The green space around the supermarket is used by local residents who do not have gardens and children from the local nursery.
