Objection to SA32, Sainsburys Green Lanes N21 3RS. Page 351 of Enfield Local Plan. Redevelopment of supermarket and car park to mixed-use homes and non-residential floor space.

The loss of a major supermarket in the area will force people to have to drive further. This would especially affect elderly and disabled residents and increase car usage on local roads.

It would increase costs of food, groceries and other items as there would be little competition.

There would be more traffic on the roads and more traffic jams as those people who have cars would have to travel further thus producing more pollution.

Other local shops would suffer as people would not be able to park in Winchmore Hill as you are closing other car parks.
