I have been a resident all my life in Enfield and feel its a disgrace you are considering building on Green Belt land. This act shows how corrupt a government can be and when you get given money from a large developer you are drooling at the mouth. How can we trust the government when 1000's of people are voting against something and then you go ahead and do it anyway. Why don't you take a vote outside your four walls and go and walk the streets and take votes from your community.

Lets take Chase Farm Hospital how many votes did you get for this against who decided to do this. A handful in your office thought this was a good idea and then it gets done. You have decided to build a load of houses on this land, now when you need AE you need to go to Barnet and wait 10+ hours to be seen, Does Enfield council offer private medical insurance to their employees, ever wondered why? Why don't you build the infrastructure 1st to support the housing.

A few years ago you decided to build a cycle lane, this is a joke. Your council even went to the local cycle comity in Bush Hill who voted against this as all cycle lanes do is fill with rubbish from the road and most cyclist would prefer to use a side street which runs parallel with this. Business's which this passes has been hugely effected not allowing customers to park outside of their shops now and having to try and find parking down the road, this is ok if you are able to walk long distances, but I'm afraid their are a lot of people in our community who are not able to. This cycle lane cost in the region of 42 MILLION to build (probably 10 Million but the rest in someone's pocket), have you ever sat and counted how many people use these cycle lane, its a mere handful and when you do see a cyclist their still in the road. You would have been better of investing this back into the community, to the struggling high street and other areas which need addressing.

The houses you have been building recently have been far from affordable the houses in Chase Farm are selling for 750k for 4 bed terraced house, the cost to build this house would have been no more than 150k + 100k for the land leaving this is being generous leaving 500k profit per house. Why can they sell a house in Newcastle, new build for 250k, the houses are identical its not like they are built out of timber up north, trades men are getting the same pay as well now as they were fed up loosing all their best trades to London. The developers are building / have built 500 houses on this piece of land, What did they pay for this land 50 million? 100 million? even at 100 million they would be earning over 125 million profit.

We can all see what is happening in our council.....
