
Please register my objections to the above proposed plans for the redevelopment site of Sainsburys Winchmore Hill:

1. Local Facilities

- a. The loss of a major supermarket in the area forcing people to drive further and the effect on the elderly and disabled in our community and further increasing car usage on local roads.
- b. No supporting community infrastructure included which will impact on existing facilities such as schools, doctors surgeries, dentists etc.
- c. With the Fords Grove car park going and 14% of car parking on Winchmore Hill Broadway gone this will lead to further loss of revenue to local shops leading to potential closures.

2. Impact on local residents due to the inevitable increase in vehicles on our roads and the increase in carbon monoxide levels impacting on locals and especially school children at Highfields school.

3. The Environment

The development will lead to the destruction of habitat and woodlands - the site is home to at least three different species of woodpecker as well as trees with protection orders namely poplars and oak trees. In 1986 the Secretary of State allowed planning permission for Sainsburys to be built with the condition that the green space was retained for community use.

These are just some of the issues that are of great concern to the community of Winchmore Hill and surrounding areas and any plans to proceed will be met with fierce opposition.
