I am writing to request that you remove all reference to Firs farm wetlands from Policy SP CL4. As a resident of the London Borough of Enfield and to whom I pay my council tax I strongly oppose the plan to sell the Metropolitan open land within the areas of Firs Farm and the Wetlands.

This area is valuable to the community and should be protected. The reasons being that it has assisted with the health and well-being of all generations. It provides vital education of wildlife and of plants in their natural habitat to children of all ages. It was invaluable during the Pandemic for recreation for both individuals and families for their mental well being and emotional health.

I look forward to a positive result during the consultation period in favour of the Firs Farm and the Wetlands being retained for future generations.
