I wish to lodge my objection to the closure and redevelopment of the Sainsburys Winchmore Hill site.

The current major supermarket is in the midst of a busy residential area, and as such many residents (myself included) travel by bike or on foot. Forcing more residents to drive to get groceries simply adds to congestion and pollution. A major supermarket also encourages visitors to other shops in the area.
