Please, under no circumstances, redevelop any part of the Firs Farm Wetlands. This is a much much loved and needed open space, used by my family daily for dog walks, running, cycling and playing. Every time we visit with the children the Friends of Firs Farm have carefully added more areas for children to play in, all the while keeping the space natural and slightly wild.

This is not at all the space to build a crematorium and I am shocked that it has even been considered.

While I appreciate that developments have to be made, it does appear that the Council is making some shocking decisions regarding development of public green spaces, such as the controversial proposed development at Crews Hill & Whitewebbs. There is plenty of brown land that could be redeveloped, but no doubt this costs the developers more to build on. The Guardian last week also highlighted the numerous golf courses in Enfield that would be better being developed, as they only serve a small wealthy fraction of Enfield's population.

Please do not be known as the administration that built over much needed green space. I would not be voting for Labour Councillors again if so.
