I am logging my objections to building a CREMATORIUM in Firs Farm Green Space.

- 1. I am a local resident and use the field every day to walk my dog, get exercise and get some fresh air
- 2. I use it to relax and to meet friends
- 3. I use the fields to play with my grandchildren
- 4. I use the fields as a cut through.
- 5. My children have used the fields and now my grandchildren use them to play football and meet their friend.

How can you propose to build a crematorium in the middle of the fields...

- 1. it would block the open space
- 2. it would bring lots of traffic into the area. I thought that the council wanted to reduce traffic or is that only for the expensive areas in Enfield.
- 3. It's not appropriate to have a crematorium in the middle of an area used where children play. For the children's sake and for the dignity of the deceased and their relatives.
- 4. It is in close proximity to a secondary school, a primary school and a nursery. It is totally inappropriate.
- 5. It is too close to residence houses.

It would be more appropriate to house the crematorium in the cemetery its self. I have only ever seen a crematorium in a cemetery not in the middle of playing fields.

I hope you will reconsider this ludicrous proposal.
