Enfield has been for hundreds of years an historic town. History shows the land was frequented by the Tudor dynasty. The development of the green belt is unexceptable. We are lucky to be the last London Borough to have green belt open spaces. The leasing of whitewebbs golf club is a disgrace and should never have been allowed. How much more of the Borough do you intend to ruin.

I can see that the Borough has planned 1000 trees in the area which is commendable but you will destroy far more in building on green belt plus hedgerows which are vital to our wildlife and environment. Plant more trees DO NOT DESTROY THEM .

Crews Hill has been a garden nursery for as long as I can remember having lived in Enfield all my life (72 years). These nurseries are vital to the area and are visited from people outside the Borough.

I appreciate that housing is needed but concentrate on converting empty disused office blocks and brown sites.
