

Objection to SA32, Sainsburys Green Lanes N21 3RS. Page 351 of Enfield Local Plan. Redevelopment of supermarket and car park to mixed-use homes and non-residential floor space.

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I am writing to express my objection to the proposed use of Sainsburys Green Lanes location for housing and commercial space. The loss of a major supermarket in the area will force people to have to drive further. This would especially affect elderly and disabled residents and increase car usage on local roads.

I do not see any supporting community infrastructure planned which will lead to an overstretch of existing facilities such as schools, doctors' surgeries etc.

The increase in vehicles on the road from potential residents of this development will increase carbon monoxide levels impacting locals and especially school children at Highfields school.

This proposed development will lead to the destruction of habitat and woodlands – the site is home to at least three different species of woodpecker (greater/lesser spotted and green varieties) as well as trees with protection orders (poplars and oak trees)

Lastly, the area is used by families and elderly alike, which contributes to the health and wellbeing of all residents of Enfield
