I am writing to register my concern with the proposed changes to the use of the Sainsbury's site in Winchmore Hill N21 3RS.

There are many reasons why I believe the proposed changes should not be taking place:

- Over population of the area, local schools are already over subscribed, the top of our road is not in any catchment area for local primary schools
- Doctors are already unable to cope with the demand of the area as it stands
- Too many apartments – given the recent and future developments along Green Lanes - Travis Perkins, Capitol House etc
- Congested roads and pressure on parking. There is already a parking issue on Fernleigh and surrounding roads
- Loss of green space – an area for families and leisure which contributes to the health and wellbeing of all residents as well as mitigation against pollution
- Totally changing the character of the area
- Inappropriate choice of site given the close proximity of existing traditional historical properties. Redevelopment of sites on the A10 make more sense as there are few properties affected/blighted.
- Potential claims for reduction in property values
- Why not develop Morrisons in Palmers Green. That would not affect any adjacent properties
